HOW IT WORKS

- 1. Contact us to discuss your research needs and we work with you to define a project.
- 2. We advertise your project to our powerhouse pool of over 5000 graduate researchers.
- 3. You interview candidates and select your preferred interp
- 4. We match your intern with an academic mentor.
- 5. You negotiate internship details with the intern and their mentor.
- 6. All parties sign a standard agreement detailing expectations and responsibilities.
- 7. Your organisation will be invoiced for the program fee, which supports a stipend for the graduate researcher.
- 8. We check in regularly to ensure the project is running smoothly.
- 9. The intern delivers their project results in a presentation and written report.

Where a graduate researcher or academic develops a bespoke internship with you, the process commences from Step 5.

PROJECT COSTS

The project fee supports a stipend for the graduate researcher and an academic mentor honorarium.

Additional subsidies are available for organisations who engage a female STEM candidate and organisations working in defence.

Whilst it is expected that research internships will be industry funded, unfunded internships may be supported on a case by case basis.


